1. Fortaleza villas, Galle, Southwest Coast

For active guests, tennis, white-water rafting, biking, hikes and more can be organised through the hotel. Alternatively, guests can relax with in-room spa treatments available or in one of the private pools or jacuzzis.

3. The Dutch House, Galle, Southwest Coast

Located a little outside of the city centre, away from the crowds but close enough to still explore, is **The Dutch House**. This country house, built back in the 18th century, hosts four grand, elegant suites for highly-private stays. A tropical English garden (including a croquet lawn), serene pool and spacious verandah area offer incredible views across what is undoubtedly a beautiful setting.

4. Jungle Beach, Trincomalee, East Coast

Sri Lanka is popular with those travellers either looking to escape the Christmas festivities altogether or celebrate in a more exotic location. The problem is many places get booked up early in the season. **Jungle Beach**, located on the island's east coast, is a great last-minute option. The east coast has more unpredictable weather at this time of year (although, let's be honest, what's a day or two of rain when you're relaxing on one of the world's most beautiful islands?), compared to the west and south coasts.

Jungle Beach provides a wonderful hideaway for this time of year. Choose from three room types: facing the beach, by the lagoon or fully-immersed in the jungle.
