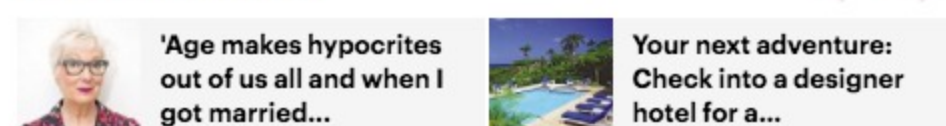
This cosy Shropshire hideaway was designed in the 18th century by architect James Wyatt

La Bastide de Moustiers is a chic restaurant with rooms, developed by chef Alain Ducasse in rural Alpes de Hautes, Provence. He was captivated by the house, its cliff views and gorgeous gardens — and you will be, too.

INSIDER TIP: Order a picnic and cycle into the countryside.

DETAILS: Rooms from €215 (£190) a night, based on two sharing, www.bastide-moustiers.com. Flights to Marseilles from £93 return in September, britishairways.com. The hotel shuts for winter from October 31 until February 28.

Experience the jungle at this luxurious huts resort next to Sri Lanka's National Park
